Proposal of good practices. -

Based on our principles we see it necessary to analyze the dimensions and structures, which tools we use and how we are developing our ecosystem, these basic principles agreed upon are: (Integral revolution, peer2peer, cryptomoniques, free knowledge, hacker ethics, degrowth, good living...)

We must use a Project Management system to address each area with sufficient criteria to avoid deviating from the critical spirit, free software practices, the integral revolution and hacker ethics so that.

Our tools must always meet the following criteria:

- Free software to promote cooperation, self-management and freedom.
- ICT tools are not an end in themselves but a means.
- We must be able to adapt to changes so we need version control.
- The operation, processes and tools must be self-learning and therefore documentation and courses available.
- We must allow the territorial structure of Glocal – languages, different cultures that connect to the global.

We propose this methodology for each area... starting with Tech and as it is cross-cutting the needs should be asked to all areas clear.

0.- Define minimum needs. 1.- Dates to cover the need. 2.- Analysis of tools and methodologies used to date. 3.- Available resources. 4.- Improvement plan. 5.- Improvement action. 6.- Monitoring. 7.- Criticism and review.

Starting with Tech area and all the tools that depend on it. Using for example this index of values in order to try to be objective:

- If he fulfills the four freedoms, one point.
- If decentralized - One point.
- If distributed - One point.
- If it is low power consumption (relative to others) - One point
- If it is KISS and modular (one use a task) - One point.
- If you have version control. One point.
- If we already have resources - One point.
- If there is complete documentation - One point.
- If it already meets the need to cover - One point.

In addition to the technical analysis, a code of conduct for communication and development based on the Netiquette and a reputation system are proposed in order to give the necessary confidence to critical tools. Netiquette -

 - Inclusive and inclusive co-operative for all of society.
- Society:
 - Equity and social justice.

- Economy:
 - To attend to the needs of the people above all other interests and each one contributing according to their possibilities.
