Some consider it as the perfect substitute of googleAPPS. The community is about 500 active contributors. Currently in development the version 12 and 11.

It could be considered mature software despite of her young age by the previous history and for having managed to migrate to the greater part of the community of users, thanks to a great work of improvement and integration of plugins.
